13/101 – PLANNING

13/1443/P/FP – Little Manor Church Hill- The Parish Council have no objection in principal to the proposal but would, however, make the following comments on the application:

- By reference to application 13/1157/P/FP (Coffee Lodge) and 13/0931/P/FP (Ball Lane). The Council would expect this proposal to require a Listed Building application for works “within the curtilage of a listed building”.
- It is difficult to assess whether the selected form of the proposed building is appropriate within its context without an indication of the adjoining buildings. Refer to West Oxfordshire District Council’s Validation Criteria for Householder Planning Applications.
- To comply with the requirements of OFTEC an oil storage tank within a building must be self-contained within a fire rated chamber and the tank be bunded. This is a planning matter.

13/102 – ANY OTHER BUSINESS

At the Forum which Councillor John Cook attended at West Oxfordshire District Council there was a talk given by the Ambulance Service on defibrillators. A wealthy benefactor has given West Oxfordshire District Council funds for groups to purchase machines. Also County Councillor Ian Hudspeth is able to provide financial assistance for this equipment from his funds. Councillor June Collier felt this should be added to the agenda for the next Parish Council Meeting.

Councillor Les Summers requested that at the next Tuesday’s surgery wording for the Council item in the Newsletter is agreed.
