13/02 - DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Councillor Robert Clow declared an interest in all items on the agenda.

13/03 – PLANNING

12/1804/P/FP - 3 Nethercote Road – No adverse comments

12/1839/P/FP – Land South of Upper Weaverley Farm – As the plans were not available at the meeting Councillor Robert Clow proposed that Councillor June Collier get hold of the copies and consult with Councillors and ask Clerk to report comments to West Oxfordshire District Council. 13/04 – ANY OTHER BUSINESS

Councillor Les Summers reported that a railway meeting had been held earlier today. Network Rail will write to the Parish Council setting out their intentions in due course. They will not support bells and lights at the crossing. A planning application will be submitted before the Summer for an over bridge and it is hoped that the work can be completed before electrification in 2014. A meeting will be held with those immediately effected and then with the full village with regard to the proposals. It was agreed that the railway crossing would be discussed at the next meeting on 28th January 2013.

Councillor Les Summers asked whether the report he had written for the village newsletter should be submitted for the next edition. It was agreed that as the precept would not be confirmed until February 2013 that an article would be submitted at a later date. To be discussed at the meeting on 28th January 2013.

Councillor Robert Clow reported that the two potholes outside the Old School House had been filled and that those on Church Hill had been marked.

Councillor Robert Clow asked that the Clerk obtained maps of all the utilities in the village.

Councillor John Cook reported that he may be able to assist with this as he had been given an email link.
