11/101 - APOLOGIES

11/102 - MINUTES

The Minutes of the meetings held on 10th October and 8th November 2011 had been circulated. It was proposed by Councillor Jim Howard and seconded by Councillor Richard Banbury that these Minutes be signed as a true record of the meetings. All in favour.

11/105 – PARISH MATTERS

- Village Hall Car Park – Street Lighting – Councillor Robert Clow proposed that the quote for erection of the street light in the car park at a cost of £4,034.20 be accepted. The cost includes £961.50 for 30 year commuted maintenance. This was seconded by Councillor Bill Denver. All in favour.

Pedestrian markings – Councillor Robert Clow did not consider that there was anything wrong with the existing markings. Councillor June Collier had spoken to the Headmistress of the Primary School and was informed that she would be putting a notice in the Newsletter to draw parent's attention to the need to watch their children when in the car park.

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- Cycle Play Area – Councillor June Collier had been approached by children in the village with regard to having a trick cycling area in the village. She suggested that the area at the rear of the hard surfaced play area might be a suitable location. The children had been asked to come up with a plan for the meeting, but unfortunately nothing had been provided.

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11/107 – TO CONSIDER OTHER MATTERS

The Clerk had received a quote for the ROSPA inspect from RoSPA Playsafe Ltd of £63.00 plus VAT. It was proposed by Councillor Richard Banbury and seconded by Councillor Bob Clow that this quote be accepted. All in favour.

Councillor Bill Denver report that the one of the swings at the play area was in need of repair as a nut appeared to be missing. Clerk to contact Hillcrest and ask them to carry out any necessary repair work.

Councillor Richard Banbury asked whether an application had been received for the windows and door which had been put in at the cottage on Nethercote Road. Clerk reported that as the house was not in the conservation area the work had been undertake under permitted development.

Councillor Robert Clow was concerned about the response received from West Oxfordshire District Council to Mr. Cooks letter regarding 44 St. Johns Road. Councillor Robin Gibbons to respond on behalf of the Parish Council. Councillor Bill Denver reported that the sewage matter at the address had been passed over to Oxfordshire County Council solicitors.
