12/011 - APOLOGIES

12/012 - DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

Councillor Robert Clow declared an interest in all items on the agenda.

12/013 – PLANNING MATTERS

Planning application 12/0168/P/FP – 48 Nethercote Road – No adverse comments.

12/014 - VILLAGE SEWAGE SYSTEM

Councillor June Collier informed the Council that this item would not be discussed as the representative from Thames Water was now unable to attend. Councillor June Collier has obtained contact details from County Councillor Ian Hudspeth and will ask if the representative is able to attend the meeting on 5th March 2012.

12/015 - PARISH COUNCIL MATTERS

The Parish Council has received a request for funding from Woodstock Youth Club. It was proposed by Councillor Jim Howard that we do not provide any funding. Seconded by Councillor Paul Joslin. Five in favour. Councillor Robert Clow abstained.

12/016 – ANY OTHER BUSINESS

Councillor Robin Gibbons reported that as there is now a new Station Manager at Oxford Station “Friends of Tackley Station” is progressing well, and a meeting will be held with the new Manager and group shortly. The additional shelter at the railway station will be pursued. He has also been looking at the Draft Transport Strategy and a reply will be drafted for consideration by the Parish Council. He has written to David Cameron’s researcher to raise the issue of metal theft.

Councillor Richard Banbury expressed his thanks to Councillor Robin Gibbons for all his hard work. This was reiterated by all present.

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Councillor Robert Clow has been contacted by the Acting Sergeant at Woodstock Police Station asking if a member of the Parish Council would like to join the Committee. Councillor Clow to ask if Councillor Bill Denver would like to join.

Councillor Robert Clow asked if the new Code of Conduct was available. Clerk has received no information to date.

Councillor Robert Clow is to join Mrs Richardson at the next bus meeting.

Councillor Robert Clow asked if Councillors had any issue with West Oxfordshire District Council investing in the tobacco industry, if this was the case. No views were expressed.

Councillor Robert Clow asked that recycling be added to the Agenda for the meeting on 5th March 2012.

Councillor Robert Clow reported that potholes throughout the Village have been marked up, including those outside his property.

Councillor Robert Clow to provide the Clerk with details of kerbing that is in need of repair so that the details can be forwarded to the Area Stewards.

Councillor June Collier reported that the first meeting of the Queens Diamond Jubilee Committee had taken place and the following low cost events were proposed:-

- DIY street party on Monday for all on the playing field followed by old fashioned games
- Possible evening event

It is also hoped that the Church will put forward some proposals. Councillor Robert Clow reported that the Church bells will be rung and a beacon lit.
